

◆ Let's have look at the FONT(1).

➤ What do you think the font is used for?

➤ How many sides does it have?



◆ Take some time to read the two information boards near to the font. They have lots of really interesting facts and pictures for you to look at.

◆ If you face the door by which you entered and look up to your left, you'll see the BELL TOWER and the ropes hanging down from the bells. Three of the bells still in use today were cast over 350 years ago.

➤ How many red, white and blue ropes can you see? _____

◆ One more secret to share with you before you leave! Can you see the little door to the left of the main door? This leads to a small room called a PARVIS over the north porch where priests might have stayed.

◆ As you leave through the north porch, sit on one of the stone seats either side of the porch. You are actually sitting on an ancient tomb slab and bought in 1686 for the sum of 12d – equivalent to 5p!

◆ As you leave the church, walk around the outside – there's so much to see: the tower, the spire, the weathervane, the clock, the gargoyles, the headstones in the churchyard. Perhaps you can do some more research of your own and find out more information about our Parish Church.
